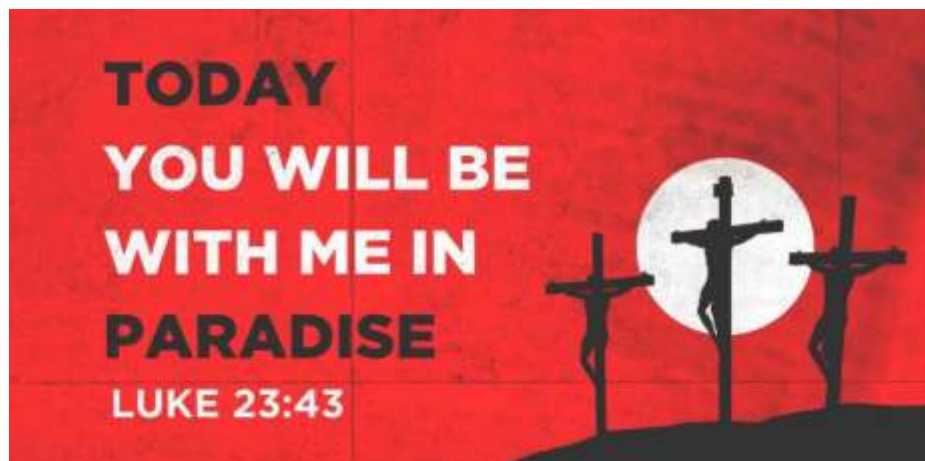

SACRAMENT OF HOLY MATRIMONY
