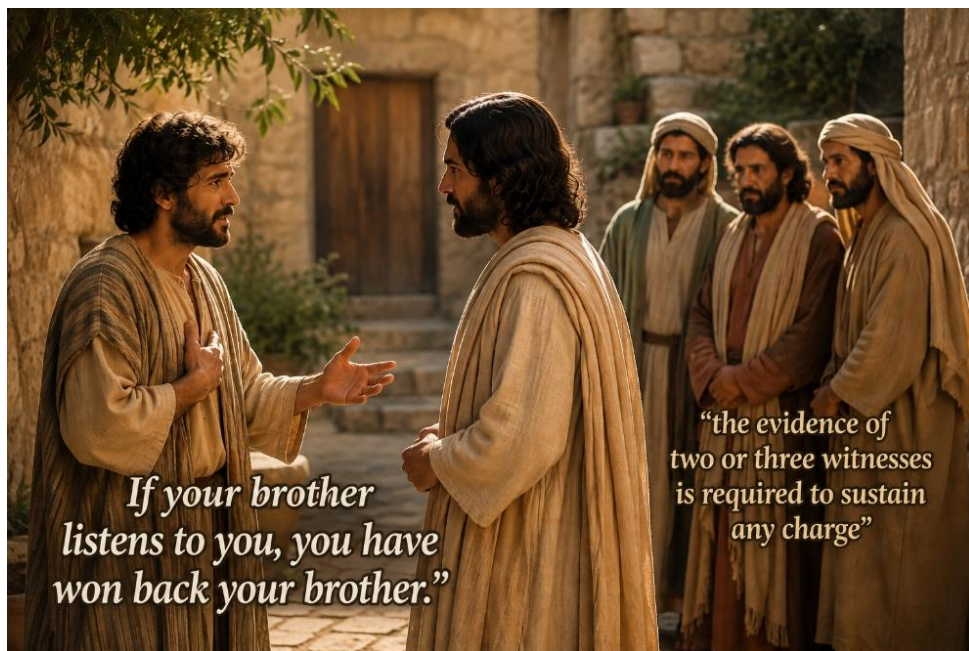

SACRAMENT OF HOLY MATRIMONY (UPDATED 25/6/2026)

For couples who are registered parishioners of this parish
and wish to marry at the Church of Mary Immaculate are
required to attend the Pre-Marriage Course at least six (6)
months to one (1) year before the proposed wedding.

The Pre-Marriage Course Certificate is valid for one (1) year.
Pre-Nuptial Inquiry interview should take place within Three
(3) Months before the proposed wedding date.

Submission of documents (full) is a prerequisite before
meeting the priests for the Pre-nuptial Inquiry Interview.

Please refer to the parish office during office hours or parish
website for list of documents to bring.

The date of marriage can only be decided during the
Prenuptial interview with the Parish Priests. Date blocking
by couples is **NOT ALLOWED**.

FUNERAL MASS

Parishioners, please take note of the following when making
arrangements for Funeral Mass:

- Step 1: Visit to **SJBF Office (088-216321)** to purchase a
tomb or burial ground;
- Step 2: Go to CMI **Parish Office** for arrangement of
Funeral Mass at CMI.

Please bring along the following:

1. I/C or Passport.
2. Baptism Certificate
3. Church Marriage Certificate. (If any)
4. Police Report or Death Certificate

EULOGY at Funeral Mass is strictly not allowed.
